fault in the strata, showing very solid vertical stones with a quite thick calcite coating. The burnt area had partially overlain this fault. The above mentioned fault appears to be running the entire ~~length~~ length of the cutting. It shows as a dark line along the top of the rocks - perhaps calcite in its early stages, and as calcite edged rocks.
