DATE EXPOSED DATE COMPLETED

DESCRIPTION: Hearth. The original area of burning (see Plan 1 N1) was sectioned North-South with eastern half removed and proved like F2551 to be a one stone layer thick area of burning. However slightly to the east of this and running into M1 were uncovered a number of large flat grey and red burnt stones with uncertain edges which most certainly looks like the remnants of a hearth.
