## Comments

On removal 9504 lay solidly dark greyish brown soil and on the reddish brown soil of the long mound in 9504 IS NOT PART of the 2951 LONG mound sequence but is separated by a turf layer. - The greyish brown soil lying not just below but also under the stones of 9504. There are more (larger (ie medium size) stones) associated with 9504 than is usually found at this stratigraphical level. ? = a later addition, a re-capping of the L.M.?
