## DESCRIPTION

..Worn area of small occasionally abraded small stones runs N-S length of cutting. After removal of layer 1 this area was expanded to east of E side of cutting, consisting of mostly compact + worn small + medium stones, possibly part of wider path, which may continue under turf to E. This road/path lies over heavily disturbed
